Roll Call: Bartley, Case, Lucas absent  
Minutes read and approved

Anderson told of two possibilities for a program to take the place of the winter sports banquet. (1) there could be a convocation to honor the teams with a speaker as the added attraction. (2) A program could be given in Alumni Hall with a speaker and movies, with speeches by the coaches and introduction of the athletes. It was suggested that the entire program might be dropped to cut expenses and to try to avoid crowding the over-crowded social calendar as much as possible.

Ricke moved and Bridges seconded that the program for the winter sports teams be suspended for this year. Motion carried.  
The secretary is to write letters to the coaches giving the reasons for the action.

The senior farewell banquet is tentatively set for April 16.

The selection of members for the new board will be handled in the same way as before and with the same qualifications. If the board is short-handed for the summer session, the old members on campus will be called on for help. Vacancies will be filled by the acting board.

Moeller reported that the insurance for the hobby show has been applied for.

Bridges reported that Mr. Fisher has arranged a new system of ushering for next year for the basketball games and will not need the union ushers.

Visher has accepted the job of ushering for the Tommy Dorsey concert for the Union service workers.

Mr. Patrick reported that he has received several letters from former board members thanking him for the minutes of the Union Board reunion banquet, and a note from Mrs. Church expressing appreciation for the resolution from the Board.

The team for the billiard tournament will be chosen Friday.

Mr. Patrick will ask President Wells to contact Wendell Willkie to see if he could speak at the senior farewell banquet.

Moeller moved and Ricke seconded that a table be placed in the Commons upon which the union board members can carve their names to serve as a permanent memory. Motion carried.

Moeller moved and Ricke seconded for adjournment at 8:15.
