Lucas announced a joint meeting of the retired and incoming Boards on Tuesday, April 28.

There was a discussion of active committees led by old members.

Mr. Patrick suggested May 4 as a possible date for the Union's Tenth Anniversary of the present building to be celebrated with an open-house Coffee Hour in the general lounge. This date was accepted. Wolf was appointed to oversee plans for the event.

Bridges moved for adjournment. Ricke seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8 p.m.
