

July 13, 1943

Roll call: All present

Minutes read and approved.

Mr. Rich reported that 255 men from the A.S.T.P. unit have joined the Union to date. He also reported that Fred Cizek's band has been booked to play for the Union-AWS dance on Saturday, July 17 for \$125. The AWS is to be in charge of arrangements for the dance, and is to establish a date bureau to aid in getting dates for the ASTP men.

Mr. Rich also said that the Dugout would open as soon as the "no dancing on Sunday law" has been revised to exclude the Dugout. The AWS is to handle the Dugout program.

Recommended by Meihaus that the Dugout be open from 2-5 on Saturday and Sunday afternoons, 7-10 on Wednesday nights, and 7-10 on Saturday nights, providing there is no Union dance scheduled. Carried.

Mr. Rich reported that an inter-fraternity lounge will be established in the Sigma Delta Chi lounge, and that Fraternities that have been evicted from their houses will be provided with rooms for files and meetings. The fraternities involved are to pay the Union \$15 per month plus the cost of periodicals for the lounge.

Recommended by Mr. Rich that the Union hire trucks to take Union members to the quarries on Sunday afternoons. Carried.

Wiggins moves that Record Hours be re-established on Sunday afternoons at 4 o'clock, the programs to be arranged by Gene Weathers. Cox seconds. Carried.

Wiggins moves that the AWS aid in arranging the Union dance and the Dugout program. Wolf seconds. Carried.

Dolaway calls for a meeting on Tuesday, July 20, at 7:15 PM.
