

July 18, 1944

Radigan opened.

Minutes read and approved. Nolan absent.

Davis made the Social Committee report. There will be a Union-A.W.S. Terrace Dance on July 29, 1944. Roxanna Wertz is now representing A.W.S. on the Social Committee. A.W.S. is making plans to purchase records. There are tentative plans for terrace dances on August 12 and August 19, 1944. Plans for the Siwash are not definite inasmuch as the Siwash Chairman, Ed Burke, reported that there is no established fund for the Siwash. Rich said that the Senior Class has always supported the Siwash in the past. Davis stated that the Senior Class officers will meet and discuss the matter.

Radigan said that the Freshman Handbook copy is ready and will be back from the printer by August 1, 1944.

Rich said that it is planned to have the Service Award banquet on either Thursday or Friday of next week, depending upon the dining room reservations. Willis was instructed to write letters to all the Award recipients as soon as it is definite as to the date of the banquet.

Willis brought up the question of increasing the size of the Board with a view toward an increase in the number of campus elections. There was a short discussion on this matter. Radigan then stated that it would be a good idea to wait until the time for membership considerations before considering this question and that the election system would probably not be reinstated until after the war.
