President Leakey opened the meeting at 7:05 p.m.

Roll Call: Murray absent

The minutes were read and corrected.

Mr. Smith inducted Rodney Rockefeller, Shelby Jones and Richard Hunter.

Kyle: Reported a profit of \$14.75 for the Terrace Dance with an attendance of 119 people. The Social Committee planned a partial fall program for dances.

Mr. Smith reported that there were 120 people at Record Hour last Friday. This Friday evening, August 12, will be the last Record Hour for the semester.

Kyle moved that we have the Service Award banquet combined with the Freshman Banquet in the fall instead of having two separate banquets. Rockefeller seconded. Motion carried.

Kyle reported that he checked with President Wells and Mr. Biddle concerning the Freshman Banquet. President Wells will be there as far as he knows now.

Mr. Smith explained the Bulletin of the Association of College Unions and explained some points concerning the Union Board. He also asked that all Union members come out to all functions, and all members must attend all Union Board meetings. He further explained that he wished to serve the Board whenever possible.

President Leakey further explained functioning of the Board and thanked the Board and Mr. Smith for their fine co-operation.

Kyle moved that the next meeting be held September 25. Jones seconded. Motion carried.

Hunter moved for adjournment. Rockefeller seconded. Motion carried.
