

The Union Board Elections Committee wishes to inform you of the following rules and information pertaining to this year's Union Board Election:

It will be held April 4, 1950 in the Men's Lounge of the Union

Electioneering will be done only in the lobby and halls

No election poll worker is permitted past the entrance of the Men's Lounge

Equal table space for both Organized and Independents will be provided in the lobby outside the entrance to the Men's Lounge (a coin will be flipped to determine the side)

An election hdq room for each will be provided on the third floor, for both parties

No other non-political rooms in the Union may be used that day. This includes YMCA, Student Senate office, Crimson Bull, Union Board Room, Union Board Office, Bryan Room

No loud speakers (P. A. systems) are permitted within fifty feet of the Union Building for election purposes.

No animals, or mascot publicity stunts are permitted in the Union

Voting procedure: Voters will enter the Men's Lounge through the south lobby door, name and Id cards will be checked, voting is done in the Men's Lounge proper, ballot deposited in ballot box near the outside door as voters exit.

This is the rules as defined for 1949, if any Union Board Members have desired changes, please mention them at the next meeting.
