Phil Broyles: Urged Board members to meet Mr. Peterson.


John Snyder: Secretaries for Board members will be provided.


A motion for adjournment was made by Phil Broyles.

Jerry Wilson reported on the Homecoming Queen.


There was discussion on revision of the constitution, in which new amendments were explained.


Phil Broyles made a motion for adjournment at 8:53 P.M.
