Social - Ruth is to put up some posters for publicity on the MRC Glee Club which will sing at Christmas Eve on Campus.

Publicity - It was decided that the remaining half page devoted to the Union Board in the Arbutus be used for written copy to be done by Norm.

Carol reported that the Dorsey Brothers cannot appear in the Pop Concert that we had hoped for. All Division heads are to tell their chairmen that they must clear all purchases of Union supplies through Carol's office before the purchases are made.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:50 pm.
