Union Board Summer Meeting

A. Mr. Jordan explained how the students' money is spent in the Union.

B. Discussion was held concerning the publicity division. A motion was made and passed to have publicity funds centralized within the Publicity Division.

C. A motion was made, withdrawn, put back on the floor, and passed unanimously to have Barry appoint the publicity council representatives as a publicity unit not as individual members from each division.

C. Opening of Formal was discussed with a question being brought up concerning where it should be held. After discussion, Barry made a motion that it be held in the Union with later discussion of limitation on ticket sales. For something new, it was suggested that the Union lounge be set up as a cabaret with tables and a combo.

Discussion and voting took place concerning choice of a band for Opening of Formal Season. Ralph Marterie, Richard Maltby, and Neil Hefty are to be contacted in that order.

D. Mass Meeting plans were discussed and each Board Member was asked to give Neil a short summary of his division for a division introduction. This was to be ready by the first Board meeting in September.

E. The plans were discussed for the Union Open House, September 12. The Board members are to give Jim Capehart material and ideas for division displays.

Following these discussions, the Board Meeting was informally adjourned.
