Union Board Meeting #5

The meeting was called to order in the Colonial Tea Room at 6:00 p.m. The minutes were read and approved.

Mr. Jordan spoke to the Board about the general plans for the new building. He went into great detail as far as what the facilities in the new area would be.

Under New Business it was announced that The Freshmen Frolic would be given by the "Y" on Saturday night, September 13th. The Union will not have a part in it this year. The Board's "First Fling" will take place on Friday, September 12th.

Mike reminded the Board that they must take action of some kind regarding backing the new magazine "Eclectic" financially. He reminded the Board that it would be an initial cost to us of \$4,000 with a \$2,000 loss. Dr. Lusk pointed out that they should have a definite staff to get magazine off the ground. After discussion the Board voted that they would not support the magazine.

Mike suggested that students using Union shuffleboard and ping-pong facilities should leave a deposit of \$.50 instead of their I.D. cards. This was put into the form of a motion and passed on by the Board.

Jim Lyons proposed a \$400 addition in the form of a modified shuffleboard game called "bank shot." Students would be charged \$.30 an hour for its use. It will bring income if Board buys it but not if the business division purchases it. The Board voted for the purchase of this equipment.

Mike informed the Board that they were to circulate on the second floor of the Union during their office hour sign up time. He also asked them to continue changing Union program as they saw fit.

Next Tuesday another tour of the building will be held. Those who did not attend this week's should go to this one.

Jerry Kabelin announced the following selections: John MacLennan will be General Chairman of the Card Section. For Cheerleader Selection, Ann Garrish will be General Chairman, Nancy Davis will be in charge of Publicity, Dotty Johantgen will handle Arrangements, Tom Purves will have charge of Judges and Acknowledgements will be made by Helen Einhorn.

Dee Benko announced that Sue Hoover has been appointed as Secretary of the Bachelor of the Year Steering Committee.
