Union Board Meeting

NEW BUSINESS

Jim Campbell asked for Board's approval for Jim Lyons to investigate the installing of stereophonic sound in the new record listening lounge. A motion was made to the effect, and it was seconded and passed. Jim made a progress report on the sales for the Pop Concert.

Mike Dann suggested that members of Union Board have dinner for the groups that will be entertaining at the Pop Concerts. This was formed into a motion, and it was seconded and passed.

Judy Hinds asked that each Director give a list to her of their Committee Chairmen, the positions they hold, telephone numbers, and addresses. All Board Members must turn in their class schedules. She announced the dates of the Alumni Reunion for which Board Members will act as hosts and hostesses. It will be Friday, November 20, 3:00-10:00 P.M. At this time will be the dedication of Whittenberg Auditorium and various activities displays.

Mike Dann announced that publicity will break after the Kingston Trio Pop Concert for the Bachelor Variety Show starring Ralph Marterie and the Hilltoppers.
