The meeting was called to order by the President, Don Johnson, at 3:42 P.M. Judy Hinds and Mike Dann were late. The minutes were read and approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS

Compliments were paid to Pete Sherman for the Rhythm Room program before vacation. Judy Barrett said that through a recent survey 75% of the students questioned did not know about the program.

DIVISION REPORTS

Tickets for the Pop Concert will be \$2.25. The publicity will break about January 13 announcing Chris Connor. The next Steering Committee meeting will be tomorrow. Block sections of tickets will be sold two days before the regular tickets sales begin.
