COMMUNIQUE MR. LYONS CONCERNING THE CARD SECTION

I would suggest we react to Mr. Dro's Card Section letter #2 as follows:

- I) Offer to call a meeting at their beckoning and follow this proposal agenda:
 - a) Have S.A.B. enumerate and comment upon the problems they have had regarding Card Section.
- b) Have S.A.B. specify how U.B. could contribute to Card

 Section management.
- c) Discuss ramifications of their proposals but be careful not to render any opinions—just conduct an honest open discussion which explores consequences of various courses of action they propose.
 - d) Have this committee draw up, in writing, a set of specific proposals for management of the Card Section.
 - e) Adjourn the meeting to take back specific proposals to each Board, U.B. and S.A.B.
 - 2) Conduct of Meeting:
 - a) At no time should any U.B. member offer an opinion which could be contrived as committing the U.B.
 - b) The Union Board President should preside at the meeting.
 - c) The meeting should not be called until they (S.A.B.) have accepted your offer to call such a meeting.
 - d) Attendance should be limited to 3 U.B. members and 3 S.A.B. members, one of whom should be Card Section Chairman and another a "working" row captain. This would be necessary to get "honest" discussion in problems. You also might consider inviting I.D.S. reporter.
 - e) Meeting should be limited to students as this, at this time, is a student problem; i.e. no advisors.
