The meeting was called to order by the President, Ray Muston, at 3:45 P.M. in the Union Board Room.

OLD BUSINESS

Forum Report - Marilyn Mignin reported that signs have been placed in all residence halls. Announcement sheets of the week's activities at the Union will be placed on these signs which are headed "Are You Interested?"
