do? — (you ought-n't to) — Just one smile on one smiling face, One cute look in a cute lit-tle place,

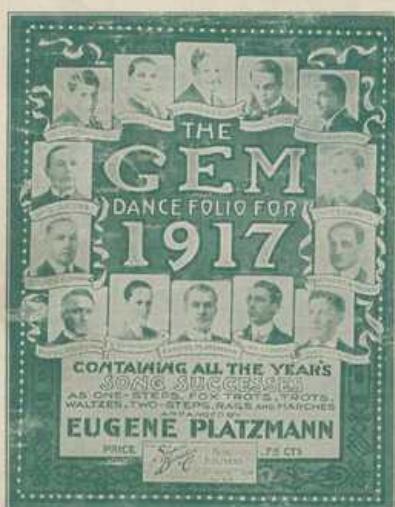
